RE: Frank Montgomery III Dies In Vehicle Crash

It is with profound sadness that I share the tragic news of the death of ABA Board member Frank Everett Montgomery III, who was killed in an automobile crash early this morning. He was 41.

Montgomery, President of Capital Trailways of Alabama, died when the vehicle he was driving struck a guardrail on U.S. Highway 231 in Elmore County, Alabama, and overturned at 12:20 a.m., according to the state Department of Public Safety. Alabama State Troopers continue to investigate. There were no passengers.

Frank was universally beloved by all who knew him. He served as the most recent Marketplace Chairman in January 2010, served as past president of the Alabama Motorcoach Association, and continued his service as a member of the ABA Board of Directors.

Funeral services for Frank are scheduled to take place 10 a.m. Saturday, September 4, following visitation at 9 a.m., at Leak Memory Chapel, 945 Lincoln Road, Montgomery, Alabama 36109-4325, phone 334-272-6501.

Frank will be sorely missed by many people whose lives he touched.
