Luis Sanchez has been the Lower Manhattan Borough Commissioner for the NYC Department of Transportation for the past five years. As Lower Manhattan Borough Commissioner, he oversees the entire area south of Canal Street.

Mr. Sanchez's office coordinates work with the Port Authority on the World Trade Center site, the Metropolitan Transportation Authority on the Fulton Street Transit Center, the New York State Department of Transportation on the Reconstruction of 9A (West Street), and private utility work for various street and building construction projects. In addition, his office issues construction permits; reviews maintenance and protection of traffic plans; directs short- and long-range planning studies, evaluates environmental assessments and planning studies; and provides design input on various Lower Manhattan projects. He also has overall responsibility for the \$150M Emergency Relief Program for street reconstruction throughout Lower Manhattan.

Mr. Sanchez holds a B.E. (Civil Engineering) from The City College of New York and an M.S. (Transportation Planning and Engineering) from the Polytechnic Institute of New York. He is a Professional Engineer in New York and New Jersey. He is a member of the Institute of Transportation Engineers, American Society of Civil Engineers, and the National Society of Professional Engineers.
