Year 2045 – No net emissions of greenhouse gases


Year 2030 – Fossile independent vehicle fleet

"Klimatklivet" - One of the most important initiatives:


- Climate investments made by companies, municipalities, regions and organizations
- Investment decisions evaluated with regards to potential climate benefits








The potential for electric buses in Stockholm




The most densely built up areas have the largest potential for electrification.
